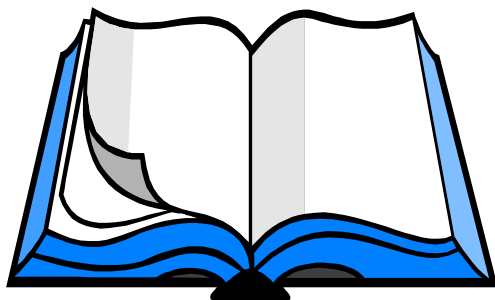

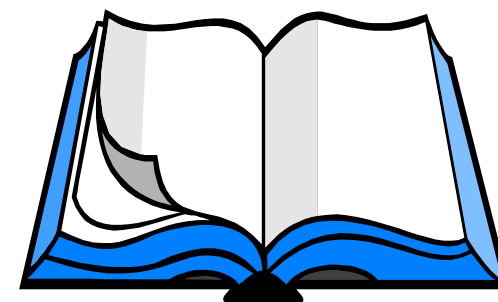

Educator Library Cards

The LLB County Libraries are committed to working with schools and educators. Library items used for educational purposes may be needed for longer than the standard three-week loan period. Educator library cards allow users to check out items for six weeks. The educator card is separate from the educator's personal library card. Educator library cards are to be used only for materials for curriculum support or classroom use. Educators must use their personal library cards for all library materials checked out for personal use.

Who qualifies for an educator card?

Teachers working in Lac La Biche County Schools **or**

Teach children in childcare, kindergarten through twelfth grade (K-12), Home School or Cyber School in the LLB County.

How can an Educator get one of these cards?

Educators must visit a LLB County Library in person and bring valid identification, plus, one of the following documents as proof of educator status:

- School or childcare identification
 - School or childcare pay stub
 - Letter on school or childcare letterhead from the school administrator or childcare director
 - Letter of acknowledgement regarding homeschooling status.

Other Services

Box Loans are now available!
Please call Maureen Penn at (780) 623-7467 with your subject requests. The library will place the requests, check items out to your educator library card and deliver the material to your school.

Loan Periods

Educator library cards allow users to borrow for six weeks, rather than the standard three-week loan period. The materials are for use in educating young children and students.

Interlibrary loan materials may not fall within the six-week borrowing period.

Renewals are not possible on materials signed out for the 6 week loan period.

An educator library card is separate from an educator's individual library card and educators are responsible for all charges accrued on their educator card, including those for lost materials.
